All persons attending the show, whether competing, grooming, spectating, or attending the show for any other reason are expected to abide by the rules of the show. Anyone found in breech of the rules will be disqualified and entry fees forfeited.

1. The Judges decision is final.

2. We reserve the right to refuse an entry without need for an explanation.

3. Any persons found tampering with the judge(s) decision be it in advance (either online, in person, on the phone, message or anyway in which is considered inappropriate conduct) or on the day of the event will be disqualified from the event immediately, sacrificing all entry fees paid.

4. No refunds will be given under any circumstances. The Show Manager reserves the right to substitute an entry at her discretion.

5. The Events company, venue, governing members and show committee are not responsible for any loss, injury or death to any persons/animals at any time whilst on the showground whether competing or otherwise.

6. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, alter, amend, amalgamate or split classes at any time during or prior to the event.

7. Any animal showing signs of disease or illness will be asked to leave the show.

8. Any exhibitor or attendants who have knowingly brought animals from stables / farms that currently have outbreaks of any contagious / infectious disease are subject to immediate disgualification and asked to leave the showground.

9. Any animals that are unruly / deemed to be unsafe will be asked to leave the showground.

10. BSI standard hats must be worn by all juniors whilst handling in the ring, mounted or driving.

11. No lunging in the collecting rings or in the car park areas.

12. Dogs must be always be under control and kept on lead.

13. Any objections must be made in writing within 20 minutes of the class / incident finishing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £50.

14. Please ensure you have valid and up to date Public Liability Insurance

15. Owners are responsible for all Vets, Doctors fees etc. incurred at the showground.

16. Please conduct yourselves in a courteous manner. Any abuse to any person or animal at the show will not be tolerated in any way, and the culprit will be asked to leave the showground immediately and forfeit any entry fees or prizes won.

17. Any height objections can be lodged with the secretary and a deposit of £50 cash on the day, this will be returned to the complainant should the animal fail to measure the required height.

18. Any complaints will be dealt with by the show Directors, and their decision is FINAL

19. No youths under 14 to exhibit a stallion OR handle a stallion outside the ring.
20. Amateur Section - This section is AOTE (Amateur Owned, Train, Exhibited).
The Horse and Handler must not have taken Supreme at a Major Miniature Horse
Show ie. MHOYS, MHCGB, AEMHS, MHS, Equi Events, BMHS

21. **Owned, Bred, Exhibited Section** – Horses to be owned and shown by the Breeder. "The Breeder" MUST have been the legal owner, or direct family member of, the Mare at time of conception. "The Breeder" need not have owned the Stallion. Foals purchase "In utero" are ineligible.

22. **UK & Ireland Born and Bred** – Open to horses and ponies which were born and bred on the British & Irish Isles

23. **Driving Section** All Competitors in the Driving Classes must hold current Third Party Liability and will be required to present a copy with their entries 24. **COOL Class** – Open to handlers who a physical or mental disability which substantially limits one or more major life activities.

25. **AMHA/AMHR/ASPC Sections** – Horses/ponies must registered with their respective society to compete in these classes. These classes will be judged as per their society rulebook. For further information please see AMHA.org and Shetlandminiature

26. **Partbred AMHA/AMHR/ASPC Sections** - Horses/Ponies to have a minimum 50% parentage ie. one parent must be registered with relevant society.

Affiliations SPSBS Affiliated Classes

- Classes must be confirmed to SPSBS registered ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society Rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.
- Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All Foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show
- To enter a stallion in any class, in hand or performance, at an affiliated show, entire males ages 4 years and over must have an "S" number and have been successfully through either the SPSBS Stallion assessment prior to 2006 or the current SPSBS Voluntary Veterinary Examination. Ridden Stallions MUST Display a stallion bridge badge. In hand colts/stallions of two years old or over must be shown bitted and are advised to display a colt or stallion bridle badge. These are available to purchase from the SPSBS

• There must be no colts or stallions in Young Handlers classes. Young Handlers must be a minimum of 3 years of age on the day of the show. Children under 14 years of age may not show colts (except foals) or Stallions in in-hand classes. Children aged under 12 years old on the day of their classes may not show a stallion in a ridden class. In the interest of safety, hard hats conforming to current British safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all handlers aged 14 years and under in in-hand classes. For Health & Safety purposes, Judges and exhibitors must remain standing whilst in the ring when showing ponies. KNEELING IS NOT PREMITTED. Hard hats conforming to current British Safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old and over. In Ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dissmounted, and take no further part.
